1. Assignments

- (a) In written form (not less than two typewritten pages) compare and contrast the sex roles of children in five recent non-sexist children's books with five traditional books. Titles and source of books used should be attached. Due date October 26th.
- (b) Book Review one child's book; seminar; not longer than 20 minutes; dates to be arranged.
- (c) Anotated Card Files of 50 books and 50 poems each; due date December 7th. All anotated books and poems must have been pre-read.
- (d) Discuss in written form the criteria (at least six to be included) for the selection of a good book. Students should be able to support her opinions with substantiated facts giving clear examples. No less than four typewritten pages; due date December 7th. Paper to include title page and bibliography and footnotes.
