COURSE PHILOSOPHY

To provide the student with a practical working knowledge in the area of infant and toddler care and learning.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- This course is designed to give the student an understanding of the physical and emotional needs of the individual infant and/ or toddler in both their home and a group setting.
- To enable the students to compare and evaluate some of the current series in research in the area and to develop a personal philosophy toward infant/toddler care and learning.

COURSE GOALS

The student will:

- Demonstrate the ability to recognize and meet the physical and emotional needs of an individual infant and/or toddler.
- Plan, prepare and present a learning device to the class; complete a written report on this. One for an infant and one for a toddler.
- Complete a written program with evidence of developmental learning materials and situations for a group care centre. (2,000 words, typewritten, with schedules and diagrams.)
