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COURSE OUTLINE

PROGRAM: Advertising Art and Graphic Design SEMESTER: Three

COURSE NUMBER: PHO 110-3 INSTRUCTOR: Neil Carter

COURSE TITLE: Photography II DURATION: 3 hours/week x 15 week

GOALS:

To use the skills acquired in Introductory Photography in an application related to advertising and illustration.

OBJECTIVES:

Students will take photographs, process the film, and print pictures that will be involved in a pre-datermined design. Students are free to complete assignments in whatever order they select, so that each student may pace his/her own progress.

ASSIGNMENTS:

Assignments are varied; students are not required to produce them in any strict order, but to experiment with them as they wish. Do not let the assignments lag to the last few classes; keep me informed of each project as it progresses.

In all the projects, students are free to be creative, but the project must satisfy given technical requirements; be sure you understand what is required from each project before you begin.

Being creative within the limits of various mechanical and chemical constraints, allows a student to learn to work professionally.

ASSIGNMENT 1:

Produce a photograph in a square format $-8" \times 8" - to$ allow for a line of white lettering reading "A Time to Relax" to be superimposed horizontally across the centre. The photograph should convey a feeling of relaxation through the subject or treatment. The photograph should feature dark values across the centre so that the lettering will stand out clearly.

Produce a photograph in horizontal format of a ratio of $3:1-9" \times 3" ^-$ allowing for black lettering reading "Smooth and Elegant" to be ^|placed in the top third of the photograph.

Produce a photograph in a vertical format of a ratio of $2:1-10" \times 5"$ with space for lettering "It's Today" in white in the lower quarter.

ASSIGNMENT 2:

Produce a "cubist" collage of at least three photographs of a face taken from different view points. Mount the photographs so that there is no space where the pictures are joined. The over-all dimensions of the photograph are $8" \times 8"$.

ASSIGNMENT 3:

Produce a collage on a theme exploring texture and pattern in an abstract sense. There must be at least two separate photographs used. Overall dimensions are $8" \times 8"$.

ASSIGNMENT 4:

Produce six photographs, each measuring $4" \times 4"$, showing elapsed time Watch that the values are the same from picture to picture.

ASSIGNMENT 5:

Produce a positive on orthochromatic sheet film. Contact print a negative from it. Print each onto photographic paper. Align the orthochromatic positive and negative and print a tone line separation

ALL ASSIGNMENTS ARE TO BE MOUNTED ONTO MATTE BOARD.

EVALUATION:

Assignments will be graded on overall effect, neatness of presentation, and success in solving the assigned problem.

Final marks will be based on a combination of projects, tests, and attendance. Students should be present for at least 90% of the classes; beyond this, a doctor's note will be expected.

All assignments must be completed according to specifications by the deadline date in order to receive a grade.

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
