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PHILOSOPHY/GOALS:

This course will help the student establish a firm foundation in English. The emphasis will be on developing grammatical and sentence structures, vocabulary expansion, and written skills.

STUDENT PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES:

On completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1. write clear, concise, grammatically correct sentences;
- 2. show techniques for dictionary use and vocabulary acquisition;
- 3. illustrate skills in word comprehension and spelling;
- 4. write and read with confidence as a competent, effective level.

INSTRUCTIONAL METHODS:

Teacher-directed work, individually and/or in small groups; critical thinking skill development through language games; cloze exercises and repetition drills are used to respond to student needs.

TIME FRAME:

This course involves three (3) hours per week with instructor, three (3) hours per week self-study, for one entire semester.

ASSIGNMENTS AND TESTING:

Students will receive on-going assessment and will be evaluated on final placement testing in order to proceed to English 097.

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EVALUATION METHOD:

Students will be assessed on the basis of assignments, comprehension and vocabulary tests, grammar and spelling tests, participation, and final tests.

A final grade will be derived from the following: Written work assigned and graded will constitute: 30% Comprehension and vocabulary tests will constitute: 30% Grammar and spelling tests will constitute: 30% Participation and attendance will constitute: 10% Total 100%
