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#### Specific Objectives:

- Given a handout and preliminary instruction on Freehand Lettering, the student will demonstrate a measureable improvement in the art over the period of the semester.

  - (a) the role of Government and Industry in forestry in Canada;
  - (b) the role of the Federal versus the Provincial Governments in Ontario forestry;

This report will review the students' education to date and outline his role in resource management programs in the area chosen. It will also include a statement of his proposals for leisure time activities and a personal program of continuing education related to his future job location and his plans for advancement.
