LETTERING:

Understanding the basis upon which all letter styles are formed is essential in the visual appreciation and execution of the alphabet. A series of exercises is designed to teach the progressive development of letter formation and letter styles. By studying the relative characteristics of one letter as compared with another, you will learn to form and design original letter styles. Letter proportions, letter spacing, and optical effects are basic discoveries in learning the art of lettering.

PROJECT #1:

LETTERING: Classic Roman Alphabet (Skeleton Letter Form)

- study in individual letters to form full alphabet
- pencil on bond or layout paper
- letters to be 1" high

B, E, F, K, L, P, R, S,	1/2 Square
J	3/8 Square
A,H,N,T,U,B,X,Y,Z,	3/4 Square
C, D, G,	7/8 Square
0,Q,	Full Square
М,	Slightly larger
	than Square
W,	1 1/4 Square

All horizontals slightly above centre except A,P,R.

Wording exercise:

"The butterfly sleeps well perched on the temple bell until it rings".

Letters are made different to appear same size.

PROJECT: #2

- Lettering The study of condensed, extended and italic letter forms based on grid system.
 - Pencil on bond or layout paper
 - Letters to be 1" High
 - Student decides the width

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PROJECT: #3

Lettering - Filled in block letters

- Inked-in letters on illustration or bristle board
- Letters to be 1 1/2" High based on the Grid System
- Must use a ruling pen
- student selects own word

PROJECT: #4

Lettering - Positive and Negative Design

- On a 10" x10" illustration board, ink in the top half of this area with a word. Below this, ink in the background of the same word.



PROJECT: #5

Lettering - Upper and lowercase

- serif and/or sans serif
- on a 10" x 10" illustration board, in black, letter the word "DESIGN" once in upperr case and once in lower case. One must be a serif letter and the other a sans serif.
