COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Ministry of the Attorney General (MAG) now utilizes independent, authorized court transcriptionists (ACTs). Being an ACT offers multiple opportunities for employment including: self-employment; working from home; opportunity to select the amount of work you wish to do and the option to partner or work with other authorized transcriptionists. When a student successfully completes this program, they can register to be placed on the list of authorized court transcriptionists. Only individuals on this list are authorized to produce and certify transcripts for Ontario Court Matters. Ideally, students will have a strong knowledge of Microsoft Office Word, typing skills, formatting, headers and footers; and a typing speed of 50 wpm at minimum is recommended. Students will receive a Sault College Court Transcript Certificate that will not expire under the current transcript model.

RATIONALE:

To prepare the student for the Ministry of Attorney General's transcription exam.

COURSE DELIVERY:

The course content will be presented through a blend of instructional methods which may include lecture, discussion, independent study, and hands-on activities.

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will be able to: apply for membership to Arkley. Once a member of Arkley, the student will be able to gain employment to court transcription contracts.
