ADV 214-04 : INTRODUCTION TO COMPUTER GRAPHICS

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

Students will be introduced to two Computer Graphics equipment systems - the Apple MacIntosh II and the Commodore Amiga 2000/3000, and to an electronic desktop publishing program - Pagemaker (Mac) - and a graphics/animation program - DeluxePaint III (Amiga). Students will learn to manipulate equipment and software to produce page layouts, cover and menu designs, and animated graphics. Printing, saving and scanning of images will be studied.

SYLLABUS

Students attend class for one three hour session per week during the 15 week semester At the mid-term point of the semester, students will switch to the alternate equipment system i.e. half semester on Mac's, other half on Amigas (and vice-versa)

- Introductory tour of Pagemaker	1 session
