TEXT: Dictaphone Medical Transcription Course Student Workbook; glossary for above workbook.

TERMINAL OBJECTIVES: To develop skill in recognizing medical prefixes, word roots, combining forms and suffixes; to develop spelling skill in transcribing medical terminology from a variety of special areas of medicine; to expose the student to some of the many formats of medical records found in hospitals.

LEARNING EXPERIENCE: Using the self-directed workbook, the student will transcribe ten lessons from the course without the use of guided text.

The student will be drilled in difficult/unfamiliar terminology from the lessons and will be able to type and spell terminology dictated by the instructor as well as give a brief definition of each term.

EVALUATION: All practice transcription will be typed as good copy first time. The material will be proofread by the student against the transcription key. All corrections will be made on the original copy before turning in to instructor for recording.

A test will be given after each two lessons on familiar material. A test will be given after the completion of all practice lessons on unfamiliar material.

ESTIMATED TIME TO ACHIEVE: 50 periods at fifty minutes each
