is to provide learners with an opportunity to engage in: 1. The critical analysis of selected ethical questions, 2. The critical analysis of nursing within a professional context, particularly reflecting on its autonomy, 3. The development of a deeper personal understanding of the meaning of being a professional nurse in practice.

4. The development of a clear understanding of CNOs Standards of Practice.

5. The critical analysis of current issues and trends in nursing,

6. Discussion relative to the future directions in nursing, 7. The development of an understanding of the legal aspects of health care and nursing.

Learning activities are designed to engage participants in reflection on professionalism in nursing practice and their own professional growth through dialogue, past and present experience and observations from their nursing practice. Case study, presentation, group discussion, LMS bulletin board postings, self-reflection and formal debate methods of learning will be used.
